Breakfast Club

The results of the questionnaire to parents on Breakfast Club provision indicated that a very small number of parents wish to avail of the service. However, there was not sufficient interest to run the Breakfast Club. From January 2020 we will not have a Breakfast Club in school. However, I will seek to re-establish a Breakfast Club either or a part-time or full-time a basis later in the academic year using our vetted volunteers.



Stepping Stones - Afterschool provider

Stepping Stones have agreed to provide Afterschool provision for our pupils from <u>Tuesday 7th January 2020 on our school premises</u>. Stepping Stones can only provide afterschool provision for primary aged pupils not nursery pupils unfortunately. We as a school have met with Stepping Stones and have ensured that the <u>pricing structure will remain the same</u> to at least the end of this academic year. The payment structure will remain at £3.75 per hour, £8.75 from 3pm-6pm and £11.25 from 2pm-6pm. Stepping Stones will also accept Childcare vouchers as payment.

For any parent looking their children to join the afterschool club on our school premises with Stepping Stones, please feel free to get in contact with Stepping Stones directly to enquire about availability and they will do their best to help you, however this will be dependent on spaces available.
