


Students may use more than one method for particular questions.

Challenge Questions




$$44 - 25 = 49$$

Freda has 49 sweets.




$$60 - 35 = 25$$

Joe has 25 pence.



$$72 - 40 = 32$$

There are 32 more adults.



$$32 - 18 = 14$$


There are 14 girls watching the film.


Challenge Questions

$$60 + 21 = 81 \quad \text{The film lasts 46 minutes}$$
$$81 - 35 = 46 \quad \text{longer the TV show.}$$

5(a)




$$32 - 15 = 17$$

$$46 - 17 = 29$$

There are 29 more books in the first pile than the third pile.

5(b)



$$46 + 32 + 17 = 95 \quad \text{There are 95 books in total.}$$
